Promundo-US, an international non-governmental organization working to promote gender equality and violence prevention, seeks a paid, part-time Research and Evaluation Intern to work in its Washington, DC office. This position will form part of Promundo's research team.

About Promundo

Founded in Brazil in 1997, Promundo works to promote gender equality and create a world free from violence by engaging men and boys in partnership with women and girls. Promundo is a global consortium with members in the United States, Brazil, Portugal, and Democratic Republic of the Congo that collaborate to achieve this mission by conducting cutting-edge research that builds the knowledge base on masculinities and gender equality; developing, evaluating, and scaling up high-impact gender-transformative interventions and programs; and carrying out national and international campaigns and advocacy initiatives to prevent violence and promote gender justice. Internship Responsibilities

Assist Promundo research staff in analyzing and writing up qualitative and quantitative research on gender, masculinities, health, and similar topics, including:

- Conduct literature searches and retrieve articles and reports, summarize existing research, and contribute to literature reviews and other desk research.
- Participate in the analysis of quantitative and/or qualitative data.
- Contribute to the development of questionnaires and other research, monitoring, and evaluation tools.
- Contribute to/draft reports, briefs, blogs based on quantitative and qualitative data for both research and non-research audiences.



- Other tasks as assigned

Required Qualifications or Skills:

- Master's student or undergraduate degree with strong focus on qualitative research methods.
- Experience with writing literature reviews and research summaries.
- Experience with qualitative data analysis required, quantitative data analysis preferred.
- Excellent writing skills and strong attention to detail.
- Experience interpreting and writing reports based on quantitative data.
- Knowledge of gender, global health, international development, and/or social justice issues.
- Personal characteristics: Proactive, able to handle multiple tasks and prioritize well, strong self-motivation, quick learner, flexible, reliable, and in possession of a sense of humor.
- Language skills in Portuguese, Spanish, or French will be an asset.

Duration

- Flexible start date; late-September/early-October 2017 preferred.
- Ability to commit to internship for 16-20 hours/week for three months, at least through the mid-December 2017, with potential to extend.
