About Promundo:

Promundo was founded in Rio de Janeiro in 1997, and works internationally to engage men and boys in advancing gender equality and preventing violence. Promundo consists of four independently registered nonprofit organizations located in Brazil, Portugal, Democratic Republic of Congo, and the United States. These four groups collaborate on high-quality formative, population-based research; develop and conduct impact evaluations; scale-up gender-transformative interventions; and carry out national and international advocacy to achieve gender equality and prevent violence. Promundo's program areas include: conflict and security; economic justice; fatherhood and caregiving; preventing violence; youth and equality; health equity; and research for action. Promundo is also the co-founder of the MenEngage Alliance, a global network of NGOs and UN agencies working to engage men and boys in gender equality. Promundo-US, a separate legal entity with offices in Washington, DC, coordinates technical assistance, strategic partnerships, and interventions outside of Brazil, carries out advocacy in the US and globally, supports Promundo's activities and fundraising across offices, and co-coordinates the global MenCare Campaign. Research Officer

Duties:

Oversees the development and implementation of an increasingly complex portfolio of research projects, in collaboration with the organization's Director of Research and Vice President for Programs and Research. This includes coordination of junior research staff, project management, implementation and daily management of research activities (including complex statistical analysis), working closely with the finance team to create and manage budgets for project costs and program expenditures, and ensuring that high-quality deliverables are within budget and expected timelines. Supports Promundo's programmatic, advocacy, and research initiatives through rigorous quantitative and qualitative research and evaluation, as well as internal and external research trainings. Represents PMO

externally with partners. Supports the implementation of major, multi-disciplinary research initiatives aligned with Promundo's core thematic areas (Research for Action, Early Childhood Development & Fatherhood, Prevention of Violence, Conflict and Security, Economic Justice and Youth and Equality). Contributes to the operationalization of short- and long-term organizational strategies. Contributes to research capacity-building sessions or trainings for staff or partners. 35% travel to visit countries where Promundo has research activities happening for technical assistance and capacity building.

Minimum Requirements:

Master's degree in Research Methods and/or Program Evaluation or closely related + at least 2 years of post-bachelor's degree experience in quantitative and/or qualitative research in at least one of Promundo's core thematic areas (Research for Action/Early Childhood Development & Fatherhood/Prevention of Violence/Conflict and Security/Economic Justice/Youth and Equality), including experience with rigorous evaluation designs (e.g. Randomized Controlled Trials and/or quasi-randomized designs) and the use of complex statistical analysis using statistical software SPSS and/or Stata + publication of at least one scholarly journal article in the fields relevant to Promundo's core thematic areas.
